Andean Abyss – Removing Enemy Bases

These are the ways you can eliminate another faction's bases. These are brief summaries. Refer to the Player Aid cards and the rules for more details.

- 1) An Event allows it.
- 2) Government
 - a) Assault: All guerrillas of the target faction must be Active and eliminated before the Base.
 - Air Strike: Base has must be alone (no guerrillas or guerrillas eliminated by accompanying Assault).
 - c) Eradicate: Select one department and remove all Cartel Bases there. This increases Aid and Opposition.
- 3) AUC
 - a) Attack: All guerrillas of the target faction must be eliminated before eliminating the Base.
 - b) Ambush: This is an enhanced form of Attack.
 - c) Assassinate: Base can be selected as the 1 enemy piece that is removed regardless of the presence of the target faction's guerrillas. AUC guerrillas must outnumber Police.
- 4) Cartels
 - a) Attack: same as AUC
 - b) Bribe: Base can be removed in the selected space regardless of the presence of the target faction's guerillas.
- 5) FARC
 - a) Attack: Same as AUC
 - b) Ambush: Same as AUC
